Attention Parents and Guardians of Rising 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students

Tdap is a **required vaccine** for all students entering sixth grade and should be completed prior to the first day of entering sixth grade. According to Virginia State Regulations, there is NO GRACE PERIOD allocated for this vaccine, thus if your child has not received this vaccine prior to entering sixth grade, he/she will not be allowed to attend school until evidence of receipt of vaccination has been presented.

Mecklenburg County Public Schools is offered Tdap clinics at each of the elementary schools on Thursday, April 23 and Friday, April 24 . Ninety-four (94) students county wide took advantage of these clinics and are now ready for entry into 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

If your child did not receive the Tdap at one of these clinics, you must have him/her immunized prior to the first day of school. You can go to your family physician or the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) for you child to receive this required immunization. Call VDH at: 434-738-6545 to schedule a date/time , please bring a copy of your child's immunization record and proof of insurance. Also, you can make an appointment with your family physician.
