

**Application for Religious Exemption from Compulsory School Attendance
Pursuant to Section 22.1-254(B)(1) of the Code of Virginia**

Virginia Code Section 22.1-254(B)(1) provides for exemptions from compulsory attendance requirements. If you wish to apply for such an exemption based upon religious beliefs, you must provide the School Board with the following information, which is necessary for the proper evaluation of your request. An incomplete application will not be processed. Your unexcused failure to provide all the information will result in a denial of the exemption. This application must be signed and return to:

This exemption may be claimed only by those pupils who, together with their parents, are conscientiously opposed to attendance at public school by reason of bona fide religious training or belief.
