

## MCPS Cafeteria Charging Regulation

## Regulation JHCH-R

A new regulation for charging meals will be implemented in the cafeterias beginning August 18, 2015. The meal charging regulation is as follows:

- Letters will be sent out by the cafeteria manger once per month for any balances over \$5.00.
- Letters from the Food Service office will be mailed to parents once per month for all balances owed over \$10.00.
- After reaching \$15.00 in charges, the Food Service office will make phone calls to parents.
- Students who owe over \$5.00 may be unable to attend certain reward activities such as dances or rewarded school trips. Prom tickets will not be able to be bought until the negative balance is paid off. Also, students may not walk for graduation until their balance is paid off.
- Students will not be able to purchase a snack from our snack cart during breakfast or lunch until their balance is paid off in full.
- Parents are urged to sign up on MySchoolBucks.com. This is a free service where you can check your child's balance as well as track their mealtime purchases. Parents can also sign up for free email alerts when their child's balance gets below a certain amount. The parent is able to choose that amount.

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
