

**We hope that this site will be helpful in meeting all of your transportation needs. As you know, the safe transportation of your children to and from school is our greatest priority. We would like to remind you of a few important tips that will help us make transporting our kids as safe as possible:**

- Always have your child at the bus stop. (In the door, on the porch etc. does not count as being at the bus stop.)
- Trying to chase down the bus is very dangerous and places your child at risk because they have to walk up the side of the bus oftentimes in a blind spot for your bus driver. Make sure to be on time at your designated stop.
- Remind your child of the safety rules found in the student handbook.
- Avoid sending oversized projects, party supplies, sporting equipment, etc. on the bus. These things need to be brought to school by the parent.
- Be sure to send notes to the school should there be an emergency and your child needs to get off somewhere else. Make sure the note is specific. We don't know where Grandma's house is located unless you give us an address.
- Always have someone home when your child is being dropped off. This eliminates unnecessary fears and thoughts because someone was there to verify your child made it home off the bus.
- Bus policy is not personal, it is the law. Please be mindful of the fact that many of the difficult decisions that are made about the safety of your child's stop are based on laws that both our office and driver must abide by. It is not personal, it is the law.
