	<b>20 = Coordinated Pre-kindergarten Classroom</b>	The program coordinates funds from 2 or more federal, state, & local government grant programs, such as VA Preschool Initiative (VPI), Title I, & Head Start. The program meets guidelines of respective funding sources.
	<b>21 = Virginia Preschool Initiative (VPI)</b>	The classroom is funded by state grants & local matching funds under the VA Preschool Initiative (VPI) for at-risk 4 year-olds, & meets VPI program requirements. The program may be operated by a school division, community agency, or independent contractor. The program does not rely on funds other than state VPI funds and the required local match.
	<b>22 = Title I Pre-kindergarten</b>	The program meets Title I program requirements and uses Title I federal funds and necessary matching funds or in-kind provisions. The program does not rely on funds coordinated from other pre-k programs.
	<b>23 = Head Start</b>	The program meets Head Start program requirements & is funded by Head Start & necessary matching funds or in-kind provisions. Program may be operated by a school division, community agency, or independent contractor, & does not rely on funds coordinated from other pre-k programs.
	<b>30 = Coordinated Special Education</b>	The student spends part of the day in a preschool special education program & part of the day in a pre-k program for non-disabled peers such as: VPI, Title I, Head Start, or child day care provided by a private provider.
	<b>31 = Special Education Only</b>	The student is served in a preschool program that serves only students with disabilities or developmental delays. The student does not participate in a coordinated special education program, in which part of the day is spent in a program for non-disabled peers.
	<b>40 = Government – Tuition Charged</b>	The student is served in a pre-k or child daycare program operated by a government agency, such as a school division or the Department of Defense, in which a tuition fee is charged to the parent/legal guardian. This includes programs in which tuition is charged on a sliding scale.
	<b>50 = Private Provider</b>	The student is served by preschool, child daycare, or other program provided by a private provider. Includes programs for-profit and non-profit providers, including faith-based programs & commercial daycare centers.
	<b>51 = Licensed Family Home Daycare Provider</b>	The student is served by a preschool or child daycare provided in a home where the provider is licensed by the state of Virginia (or other state in which the program operates).
	<b>60 = No Formal or Institutional PK Program</b>	The student was at home with a caregiver or in the home of another caregiver who was not licensed by the state of Virginia (or other state in which the program operates).
	<b>61 = Other</b>	The student attended a preschool or child daycare program that does not fall into any of the above categories. If a child attended a combination of any of the above programs one of the above programs must be selected as the primary provider. Do not use "other".
	<b>99 = Not Provided</b>	No information was provided regarding the kindergarten student's PK experience.
